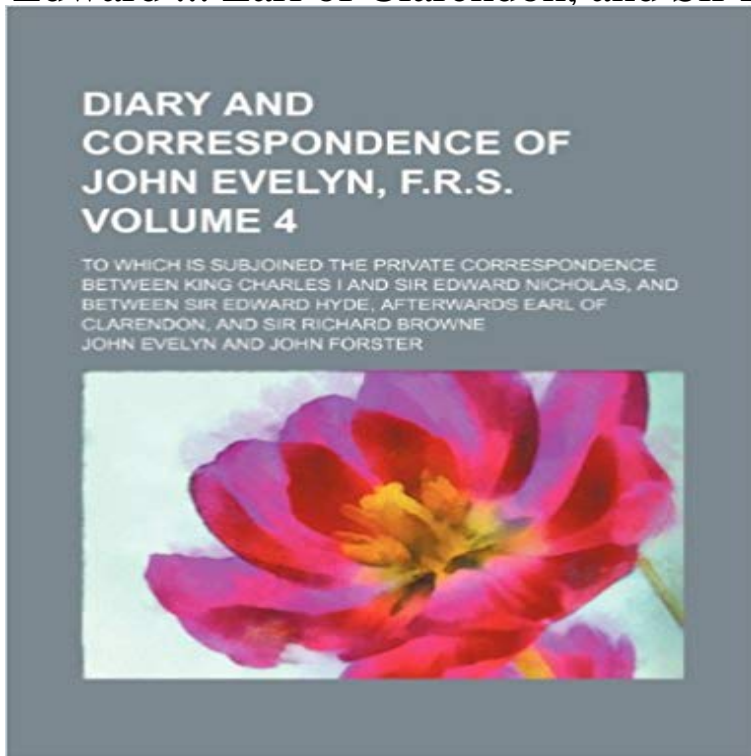

S, I haue yours of the 31 and the 6. of this moneth: and you had receaued an answer to the first before the last had come to my hands, if it had bene in my Eower to haue returned you such a one as could haue satisfied my selfe. I was as full of the sense of the iniury and indignity that is offred to your Captaynes at Brest, and truly so is the Kinge, as they could wish, but you know iniuryes and acts of iniustice are not as soone remedied and repayed heare, as dicouered: The King wished young Ld Jermin, Mr. Atturmy and my selfe, to consider what was to be done, and wee were all of opinion, knowinge what Princes all Gouvernors are at present in ffrance, that it would not be fit to moue the Courte,
