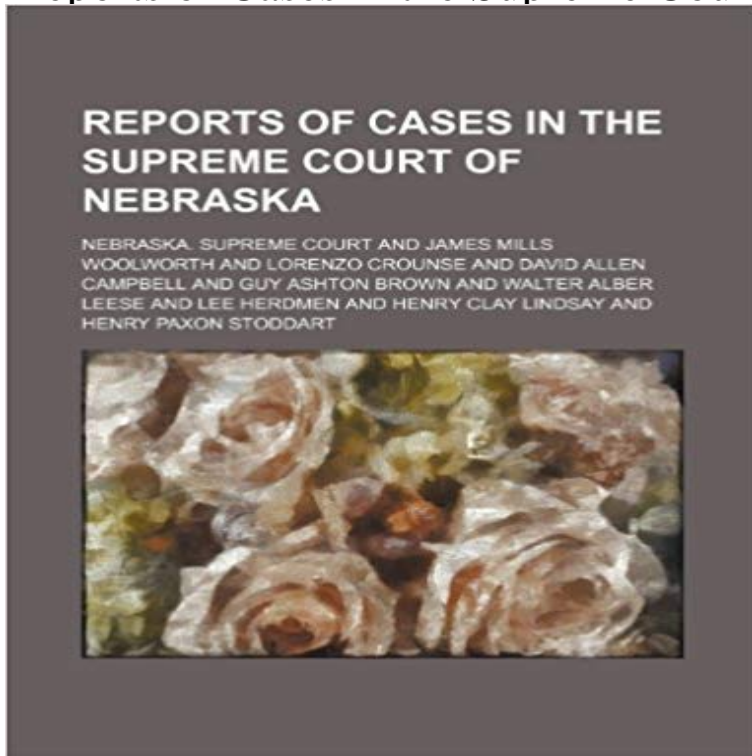

In Thompson v. Sharp, 17 Neb., 69, it was held that in proceedings instituted under the provisions of the Code to vacate a judgment after the term at which it was rendered the court must first pass upon the grounds to vacate the judgment, and if the grounds alleged for its vacation were established, the court should next inquire into the cause of action or defense, and if both these matters were found in favor of the applicant, the judgment should be set aside; otherwise not. In Osborn v. Oehr, 29 Neb., 661, it was held that a court of equity would not set aside a judgment regular on its face unless it was shown that no cause of action existed at the time in favor of the party obtaining the judgment. See, also, Janes v. Howell, 37 Neb., 320, and Bond v. Wycoff, 42 Neb., 214, where the court, in construing said section 606 of the Code, said: Before plaintiffs in error were entitled to have the judgment against them set aside, it was necessary for them to allege and prove that they had a valid defense, in whole or in part, to the cause of action stated in the petition.
